



- Can latecomers repeat/compete?


## Hypotheses

Individual-level predictors of national pride have higher predictive power than country-level predictors.

## **Datasets**

- Integrated database of the World Values Survey
- World Bank dataset (GDP per capita in current US dollars).
- Fractionalization dataset compiled by Alesina and associates (Index of Ethnic Fractionalization).
- World Integrated Time Series Dataset


### 5 Most and 5 Least Proud Countries






## Country-Specific Correlations with Happiness
